QUIZ: δοῦλος with def article, vocab words

REVIEW: circumflex: only on long vowel, never on antepenult, changes to acute when ultima is long

DISCUSS:

- 51 only two voices in English, but THREE in Greek!
 - 52 middle is subj acting "with reference to" himself. Either 1) directly ON himself, or 2) FOR himself. Exact meaning depends on defn of verb, and context. Sometimes untranslatable.
 - 53 conjugation of middle, λούομαι / note diff. betw direct and indirect meanings (contrast λούομαι, I wash MYSELF, and ἀγοράζομαι, I buy FOR myself)
- marg** note tenses whose passive voice is different than the middle: future, future perfect, 1 & 2 aorist
- 54 endings of middle: -μαι, -σαι, -ται, -μεθα, -σθε, -νται (only -σαι changes to -η through contraction)
