REVIEW: Lesson 24 pg77/ 2nd aorist / aorist undefined action, punctiliar / generally PAST time / diff w impf is punct v. durative / STEM different in aor, simplified, often shorter / 1st or 2nd aorist - have to look up to find out / middle and passive voice DIFFERENT in aorist (unlike pres, impf) / aorist has no exact English equiv, hard to translate
