**οὐδεὶς** adjective pronoun cardinal nominative masculine singular from οὐδεὶς  
*no one, nobody*

**τεθέαται** verb indicative perfect middle or passive deponent 3rd person singular from θεάομαι *behold, look at, look over, see*

**τετελειωμένη** verb participle perfect passive nominative feminine singular (see context) from τελειόω *perfect, make perfect*

**δέδωκεν** verb indicative perfect active 3rd person singular from δίδωμι *give*

**εθεάμεθα** verb indicative perfect middle or passive deponent 1st person plural from θεάομαι *send out; in relation to a sender send with a commission*

**σωτῆρα** noun accusative masculine singular from σωτήρ, ἦρος, ὁ as the agent of salvation or deliverance *savior*

**ὁμολογήσῃ** verb subjunctive aorist active 3rd person singular from ὁμολογέω *confess, bear witness*

**ἐγνώκαμεν** verb indicative perfect active 1st person plural from γινώσκω *know*

**πεπιστεύκαμεν** verb indicative perfect active 1st person plural πιστεύω *believe*
